Purpose & Philosophy

The 42nd annual OBA Compliance School is designed to provide an extensive body of knowledge and information on consumer compliance that can contribute to the development of compliance officers and to their associated functions, both of which have become an integral and essential part of our evolutionary banking industry. Students will return to their banks equipped to deal with compliance regulations that impact lending practices and deposit functions as well as other related federal and state laws and regulations.

Target Audience

The school is designed for those directly involved in the day-to-day compliance function as well as those who are involved in specific areas. Compliance officers, auditors, bank counsel, loan officers, cashiers and bank trainers will benefit from the course. Enrollment is limited to 50 students. OBA-member banks will receive first priority.

School Plan

The school consists of four-and-a-half days of instruction. Each student must attend each class, and participate in the case study to qualify for a completion certificate.

Each student will be required to attend every class until adjournment on Friday, Aug. 23. An attendance record will be kept and his or her respective bank shall be notified at the close of the session if the student's participation is not satisfactory.

All students are required to take the examination.

Registration

Students will register at the Oklahoma Bankers Association's Harris Event Center from 8:30-9 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 19. Formal classes are held Monday through Friday. School will conclude by noon on Friday, Aug. 23, 2024.

Enrollment Requirements/CRCM Credit

All employees of banks, which are members of the Oklahoma Bankers Association, who can benefit from additional training in compliance matters are eligible to attend. It is recommended, however, that students have three years service in banking OR have at least one year's experience in a functional area of banking such as lending officer, compliance officer, auditor, cashier, etc. Enrollment is limited to 50. Approved for 30 CRCM credits.

Dress

Dress for class is informal, but in good taste. Tailored shorts and jeans are acceptable. Plan to bring a light sweater or jacket. A backpack or tote bag would be helpful.

Accommodations

The Oklahoma Bankers Association has a block of rooms available at the Residence Inn by Marriott OKC Downtown. The hotel is located at 400 E Reno Ave, Oklahoma City, OK 73104.
