2024 OPERATIONS SCHOOL

Purpose & Philosophy

The Oklahoma Bankers Association's Operations School is designed to prepare junior-level officers to mid-level operations managers to manage effectively and efficiently an operations function within a bank. Students are exposed to numerous concepts that impact your bank's bottom line. This is accomplished by providing the opportunity to:

- Develop a thorough understanding of key operations areas, their interrelationships and their contributions to profitability;
- Develop and apply analytical skills in proven techniques such as work flow analysis, financial analysis and quality indicators;
- Strengthen management skills in relation to human resource planning and motivational techniques;
- Become aware of the regulatory and competitive factors that affect banking today and the overall impact these environmental factors have on all operations functions;
- Evaluate state-of-the-art technologies within the banking industry that promote cost effectiveness, encourage new ideas, incite product creativity and enhance bank profitability.

Registration

Students will register at the Oklahoma Bankers Association's Harris Event Center from 9:00-9:30 a.m. on Monday, Nov. 18, 2024. All students are required to register during this period.

Enrollment Requirements

The school is designed for operation officers, supervisors, bank trainers and branch managers and their assistants. There is no limit to the number of employees any one bank can send to the school. However, enrollees should meet the following criteria:

- A college degree and two years of banking experience, or
- A high school diploma and five years of banking experience, with a minimum of one year in a supervisory capacity, or
- Equivalent coursework and demonstrated knowledge.

Class Organization

So that each student may gain the most from the course, enrollment is limited to 50 students. Formal classes will be held approximately 35 hours, Monday through Friday. The school will conclude by noon on Friday, Nov. 22, 2024. Bankers, attorneys, and consultants teach the course.

Requirements & Regulations

Each student will be required to attend every class until adjournment on Friday, Nov. 22, 2024. An attendance record will be kept and his or her respective bank will be notified at the close of the session if the student's participation is not satisfactory.

Additionally, an exam covering all of the topics discussed during the week will be given on Friday morning. All students are required to take the exam on Friday.

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Dress

Dress for class is informal, but in good taste. Jeans are acceptable. Plan to bring a light sweater or jacket.

Accommodations

Reservations should be made by Saturday November 2, 2024 to guarantee this rate.

The Bottom Line

The cost for the one-week school is \$1,400 for OBA-members and \$2,800 for non-members. The registration fee covers daily lunches, snacks, a one-year subscription to the *Oklahoma Banker*, books and tuition. The fee must accompany the application and be received by the OBA by Nov. 1, 2024. Upon cancellation by Nov. 1, 2024, the full fee will be returned to the bank. A \$700 cancellation fee applies to refund requests received between Nov. 1 through Nov. 8. Cancellations received after Nov. 8, 2024 will be subject to forfeiture of the registration fees. All cancellations must be in writing.

EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION: Any registrant enrolling prior to Oct. 18, 2024, will be afforded the

following discounted rate: \$1,300 OBA members.

MULTIPLE REGISTRATIONS: Any OBA-member bank enrolling two or more students will be
